The meals are packed specifically to Gorgo's size, coming frozen and vacuum-sealed. All you have to do is defrost and serve. She absolutely loves the food and we have seen a clear improvement in her energy-levels (former couch potato!), skin and fur. It's been very reassuring to know exactly what goes into the food we serve our beloved fur-baby.

It's convenient to receive a fresh supply of meals at our doorstep every two weeks, and delivery is free of charge. I also love the fact that 10 percent of profits go to helping local animal shelters!
